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Siorra Vittoria

This three-story early-19th-century mansion has been carefully renovated and converted by the descendants of its original owner, Loukas Metaxas, into boutique hotel and named after its most recent residential owner whom locals affectionately called Siorra Vittoria.

Guestrooms combine the stately elegance of the original residence with modern conveniences, and are prettily appointed in soft tones that accent the wood surfaces and antique furniture. Pastel-colored walls painted using the stucco Venetsiano technique, fluffy down quilts, dimmer switches, mini bar, LCD TVs, and choice of complimentary cotton or velveteen bathrobes signal the hospitality guests can expect. Facilities include ground-floor dining room and lounge where guests luxuriate in the elegance of the Old World ambience. On balmy days, breakfast is served in the pretty garden, which is also suitable for weddings.
